Rev. Michael E. Connors, csc

Rev. Michael E. Connors, csc, is the director of the John S. Marten Program in Homiletics and Liturgical Studies at the University of Notre Dame. He had been a member of the North American Forum on the Catechumenate. He is the editor of To All the World: Preaching and the New Evangelization (Collegeville: Liturgical Press, 2016) and We Preach Christ Crucified (Liturgical Press, 2015).

He is the author of Inculturated Pastoral Planning: The U.S. Hispanic Experience (Rome: Gregorian University Press, 2001).

Joseph Paprocki, DMIN, is the national consultant for faith formation at Loyola Press in Chicago. He has more than thirty-five years of experience in pastoral ministry in the Archdiocese of Chicago and is the author of numerous books on pastoral ministry and catechesis, including Great Is the Mystery: Encountering the Formational Power of Liturgy (Chicago: Liturgy Training Publications, 2013),
